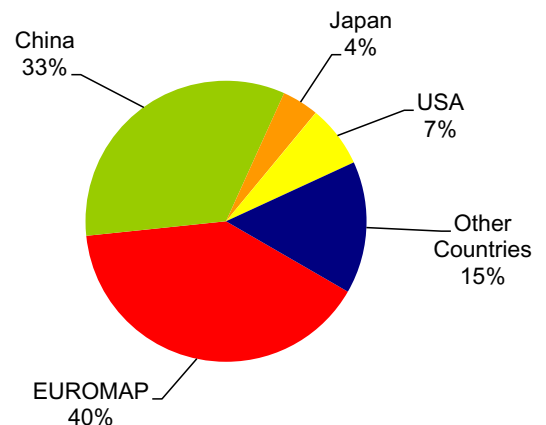

Industry figures at a glance

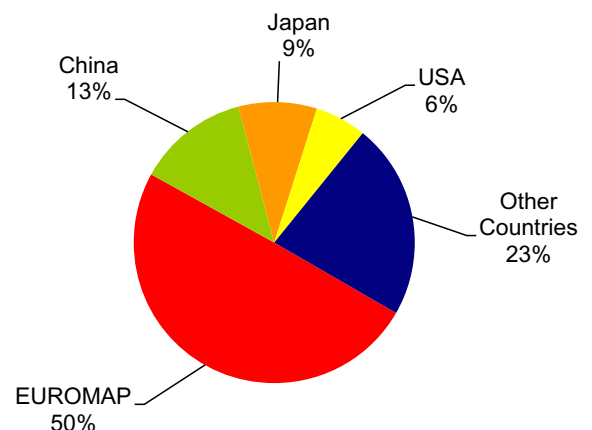
EUROMAP represents around 1,000 companies manufacturing equipment for the plastics and rubber industry in the field of core machinery (pre-processing, converting, post-processing).

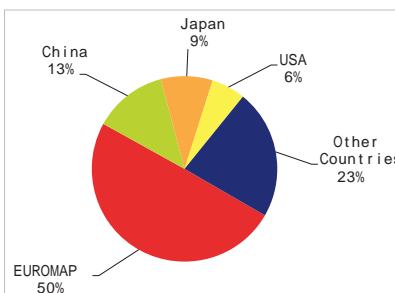
